### Last Time at the Lake... Miscues Prove Costly for GreenJackets

The GreenJackets saw yet another multi run lead get erased Tuesday night as they dropped their third straight game to the Hagerstown Suns and concluded the seven game homestand with a 1-6 record.

The GreenJackets led 3-0 going into the fifth inning. With two on and two out in the top half of the inning, Angelo La Bruna singled home a run to put the Suns on the board. Blake Perkins followed with a single to score another run. He advanced to second on a throwing error by Michael Bernal. Telmito Agustin then hit a ground ball to first baseman Jose Vizcaino. Vizcaino ended up throwing the ball away in an attempt to toss it pitcher Garrett Williams who had gone over to cover first, allowing two more runs to score and the Suns to take a 4-3 lead.

The big fifth inning by the Suns put a damper on what was an outstanding performance by GreenJackets starter Garrett Williams in the loss. He struck out five through seven innings and gave up a total of five runs off six hits. He faced the minimum through the first three innings.

With one out in the bottom of the second, the GreenJackets struck first when Sandro Fabian and Michael Bernal hit back-to-back doubles to make it 1-0 GreenJackets. With two outs and runners at the corners, Cristian Paulino singled home Bernal extending the lead to 2-0. Carlos Garcia followed with an RBI single in his GreenJackets debut making it 3-0.
