GreenJackets March to Victory Military Style GreenJackets Roll to Snap Four Game Losing Streak

Augusta, GA-The Augusta GreenJackets treated the 5,169 fans to an exciting display of baseball Saturday night as they rolled to an 8-3 victory over the Hagerstown Suns on the 11th Annual Military Appreciation Night at Lake Olmstead Stadium. The victory snapped a four-game losing streak and improved the GreenJackets to 12-16 in the second half.

The GreenJackets took control of the game right from the start. Cristian Paulino led off the bottom of the first with a single. He stole second and advanced to third on a single by Jean Angomas. Kelvin Beltre singled him home to put the GreenJackets on top 1-0 early.

Paulino hit another single with one out in the third. Angomas then drew a walk and Beltre hit another single to load the bases. With two outs, Jacob Heyward was hit by pitch to score Paulino and make it 2-0. Jose Vizcaino hit a double to score two more extending the lead to 4-0.

The GreenJackets continued to add on to their lead in the fourth when Angomas hit a two-run single to make it 6-0. With the GreenJackets leading 6-3 in the seventh, Vizcaino hit a two-run to give the GreenJackets the 8-3 lead.

Domenic Mazza continued his solid 2017 campaign with another successful outing on the mound. He went seven innings and gave up three runs off six hits, walked two and struck out three. He was only one over the minimum through the first four innings before running into trouble in the fifth. The Suns cut the GreenJackets 6-0 lead in half, but Mazza got out of the inning and made the sun set on Hagerstown's rally.

The GreenJackets will be back in action Sunday evening for game two of the four-game series with the Suns. First pitch is scheduled for 5:05pm with the gates opening at 4:00pm. It is Super

Splash Day as well as Touch-A-Truck as part of Junior Jackets Kids Club Day presented by Associated Credit Union, EdVenture Kids Museum, Pediatric Partners of Augusta, Tum-E Yummies, and PDQ. Kids ages 12 and under will also be able to run the bases after the game. Before the game, kids will be able to play catch on the field with the players.

Stephen Woods (5-6, 3.48) will start on the mound for the GreenJackets against McKenzie Mills (11-2, 3.13) for the Suns.
